FAQ'S for SIEMENS DSIII PRESSURE TRANSMITTERS



Question: My Siemens transmitter is locked up because my nightshift technician locked my pushbuttons out in Mode 10.

<u>Answer:</u> Read your manual, however, since were on the phone together hold the far left mode button for 7 seconds. and it will unlock the transmitter for you Mr. Customer.

Question: How do I set this thing up cause I see Modes 2 and 3 and 5 and 6 all do the same thing?

<u>Answer:</u> Use Modes 2 & 3 for zero and span if you have an air supply to the transmitter. If you do not go to Modes 5 & 6 and this will allow you to scale the unit WITHOUT a pressure supply.

Question: I just installed my Siemens Pressure Transmitter and it is reading a slight pressure on the unit and I know there is no pressure in my tank or line at this time?

<u>Answer:</u> Go to Mode 7 and hold down the + and - keys at the same time until the unit zeros itself for your particular mounting consideration and/or offset you have programmed into the unit.

Question: My Siemens Pressure Transmitter has been on the shelf for 6 years as my job is now finally being commissioned. What warranty do I have left on the device at this point as it has never been powered up or used?

<u>Answer:</u> All Siemens DS3 transmitters have a 5 YEAR WARRANTY from the intial time of power up as the unit has an internal clock to keep track of this. In the 4th and 5th year of the WARRANTY it is pro-rated to 50% etc.
